The starting order for the CONDO 750 will be determined by a prologue which will commence immediately after the compulsory Driver's Briefing (to be held at 12.00pm AEDT on Friday the 30th March 2018).

All Moto's & Auto's will commence the prologue from the Showground, and return to the Showground after completion, by the standard route charts as used in the event. The prologue is completely route charted and relies on Drivers and Navigator's skill to successfully complete the course.

The start order of the prologue will be determined by sign on order.

The prologue will consist of a competitive section of 34.80 Kilometres, and transport of 19.39 kilometres.

The time taken in the prologue will determine the starting order, for both Autos & Motos,

The quickest will start first on Saturday, and progress on prologue results. In the event of a tie, the Clerk of the Course will determine who starts first.

The time taken for the prologue, will also become part of the overall time for the event.

The Start Order of Leg 1 (Saturday) as determined by the prologue will be posted on the website and displayed at the showground headquarters when practical after 18:00 hrs Friday 30 March.

The Starting Order for Leg 2 shall be in order of ascending total penalty times within descending numbers of sections competed on Leg 1. Where there is a tie there will be a count back, if that does not determine the restart order, the Clerk of Course will determine which vehicle starts first.

NOTE: All Clerk of the Course decisions on the Starting Order are final.
